PRODUCT BULLETIN

Description

ConClean is a clear liquid which is a blend of acids and surfactants to clean concrete and masonry surfaces in one operation without noxious fumes.

Uses

- Removes efflorescence from masonry
- Cleans coloured brick without damaging brick colour
- · Polishes aluminum, brass and chrome
- Cleans concrete, granite₁ marble and terrazzo

Application

Masonry Cleaning:

- 1. Saturate surface to be cleaned with water.
- 2. Apply diluted solution of 1 part ConClean to 5 parts clean water. Note: Add ConClean to water; do not add water to ConClean.
- 3. Brush surface after solution has had a few minutes to react.
- 4. Rinse thoroughly with clean water.

Masonry Removal:

- Dampen application area
- Apply ConClean as-is or dilute in up to 3 volumes of water.
 Note: Add ConClean to water; do not add water to ConClean.
- 3. Agitate the surface with a stiff broom or brush.
- 4. After scrubbing let surface stand for 15 to 20 minutes before rinsing thoroughly with clean water. If surface dries, re-mist and re-brush.

Limitations

Do not mix with other cleaners. Keep from freezing. Use in well ventilated areas. ConClean must be stored in plastic containers not metal containers. Protect adjacent surfaces from overspray. when diluting ConClean always add ConClean to the diluting water. Never add water to ConClean.

First Aid

Acid solution. If swallowed do not induce vomiting. Immediately drink a large quantity of water and then drink milk of magnesia. keep patient warm and quiet. Call a physician immediately. If ConClean is spilled on your skin, or splashed into eyes₁ flush skin with plenty of clean water for <u>at least 15 minutes</u>. **Lift upper and lower lids occasionally. Call physician immediately. If ConClean contacts clothing, remove and wash, separately, before re-use. Keep out of reach of children. Protective clothing and goggles should be worn. Use in well ventilated areas.

Clean Up

Clean tools and equipment with clean water immediately after use. Wash hands and unprotected skin with soap and water.
